llampo *nm* [Bol, Ch] finely broken or otherwise easily exploitable ore
llampu *nm* [Bol] pure sublimate of sulfur

llanada *nf* plain (of great extent but fully in view)

llanca *nf* [Ch] any blue-green copper silicate mineral used by the Aurucanian indians of Chile as jewelry

llaucanero *nm* [Ch] miner who breaks up large fragments of ore with a *llaucana*
llaucar *vtr* [Ch] to use a *llaucana*
llauckana *nf* [Bol] pointed metal bar used to bar down the roof and walls of a mine
llave *nf* section of ore or wall rock in the form of an arc which is left in place to support the roof of a mine | [Sp] crib
llogada *nf* [seis] arrival | *ll. sísmica* cable break
llegar a planes *vtr* to bottom (mine workings)
lleira *nf* deposit of pebbles and coarse gravel
llena *nf* alluvium | flood, overflow of a river
